SSC MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL FORM – FY 2019/20

The Senior Services Coalition represents nonprofit and public organizations and stakeholders who are working together to ensure that older people in Alameda County can rely on an easily accessible, coordinated system of social, medical and supportive services.

Your Membership supports collective priorities:

- Strengthen the aging services voice in shaping policy.
- Increase funding for aging services and strengthen the safety net for economically insecure seniors.
- Build collaborative bridges and support partnership development.
- Promote systems change to improve access to and coordination of services.

Membership Dues are used to:

- Pay for staff to advance coalition priorities.
- Amplify advocacy efforts through web site and communications.
- Produce compelling material and data that bring home to policy makers the reality of aging issues.
- Lobby for legislative change when other funding won't cover lobbying.

Full Members are entitled to discounted registration for SSC's Fall Conference and other events.

Full Member (senior and disability serving organizations; full members have full voting rights):

- \$2,700 per year (organizations with budgets over \$5 million)
- \$1,500 per year (organizations with budgets over \$1.2 million)
- \$600 per year (organizations with budgets between \$800,000 and \$1.2 million)
- \$360 per year (organizations with budgets between \$500,000 and \$800,000)
- \$120 per year (organizations with annual budgets under \$500,000)
- Commissions on Aging (dues exempt; resolution/minutes affirming membership attached)
- Requesting dues reduction or exemption (please follow guidelines on page 2)

Individual Member (stakeholders who participate fully in SSC activities but do not vote)

- \$50 per year
- \$100 per year
- \$500 per year

Guidelines for SSC Membership

Full Members

Organizations that serve seniors and people with disabilities in Alameda County may be full members with voting rights, and thus determine SSC's policy agenda and priorities. Full members are also eligible to serve on SSC's Steering Committee, which guides SSC's staff and scope of work.

Selecting dues level - SSC's sliding scale dues structure is linked to the size of a member organization's budget (that is, annual expenditures). Revenue from dues is a cornerstone of SSC's budget and is necessary for covering our core costs and keeping staff. However, participation in the coalition is essential to SSC's success, and ability to pay dues must not be a barrier to membership. Therefore, the following options are available:

Requesting dues reduction - Many organizations have multiple divisions that do not serve seniors, or have budgets highly constrained by restricted funding streams. We ask that members use their best judgment when selecting their dues level, weighing their ability to pay with a recognition of SSC's value to their organization and the aging services system. If you choose to select a dues level that is lower than your organization's formal budget size, simply check the box on the Membership Renewal Form that corresponds to the dues amount that you are selecting, check the box for requesting dues reduction, and send in the form and dues payment.

Requesting dues exemption - Organizations who wish to request an exemption from dues in any given fiscal year may do so by filling out the membership renewal form and emailing it to wendy@seniorservicescoalition.org.

Individual Members

Policy Makers, stakeholders and other individuals who support the Coalition's mission are welcome to participate as individual members. Individual members do not have voting rights, but otherwise may participate fully in all Coalition activities.

Selecting dues level - Several individual member dues levels are suggested on the Membership Renewal Form. Individuals are asked to select payment level based on their ability to pay. Additional donations to SSC are always welcome.
